The College

Theme of the Seminar

"Popular Uprising in the Jungle Mahal (19th & 20th Century)"

The connotation, Jungle Mahal (Forest region), and popular uprisings are inter connected.

The South-Western region of Bengal was covered with dense forests and was inhabited by aborigines (Adivasi) who were independently ruled by the local Rajas or landlords or by local Sardars. The repressive policies of the British were imposed on these forest dwellers and they were stripped off their occupations and resources. The people were seething in anger and discontent and they rose in armed agitation against the British in the like of Chuar Revolt, Bhumij Revolt, Kol Rebellion, Santhal Revolt, Sepoy Munity, Indigo Revolt and Munda Revolt.

In the beginning of the 20th century, Jungle mahal rose against Bengal partition and thereafter played a prominent role in Non Co-operation movement (1919), Salt Satyagraha and Civil Disobedience Movement (1930) and Quit India Movement (1942) etc. The anti-British Movements of Jungle Mahal added a new dimension to the freedom struggle movement which ultimately came to be an end by the Bhasha Andolon of Manbhum district (1956) in the post independence

The Department of History, J. K. College, Purulia proposes to organize a seminar on the above theme, with an aim to generate interest among students on the local history of the region, so that they may grow a sense of belongingness.

Our objectives will be to focus primarily on certain issues related to our proposed theme. They are follows -

Sub Theme:
